

COURT MONITOR

A complete volunteer schedule will be printed and posted at the Information Booth.

You will be in charge of 2-3 courts in one of the 4 areas: Chamber parking lot, Senior Center parking lot, Cherry Street and behind the Chamber of Commerce.

Duties include:

- Making sure 2 teams show up
- Making sure you have a referee and score keeper
- Answering any questions parents may have. (You will have a complete game schedule, rules and court map to help answer questions)
- Keeping an eye on unruly situations and either settling them down or finding a committee member. Rule #9 states a technical will be given in these situations.
